After your 3D files have been created or downloaded, Dremel's "slicing" software is available on the three desktop PCs in the Makerspace to prepare your files for printing. *Please create your project before submitting this form.* You may submit .gcode (sliced) files either via flash dive or by email to makerspace@glencovelibrary.org. The charge for 3D printing will be \$1.00 per hour, chargeable in 15 minute increments. Patrons are responsible for payment regardless of the success or failure of the print job. Individuals wishing to use the Makerspace must have a Glen Cove library card in good standing.
