What does the word "caretaker" mean?






- The word caretaker literally translates to: A person who takes care of someone else.

What does a caretaker do?




- A caretaker may do a number of different tasks such as:

 - Assist with eating, bathing, and some other tasks to ensure the person's well-being.










Age	Noun	What is the patient's age ?	
Ambulance	Noun	The ambulance is on its way.	
Antibiotics	Noun	The antibiotics are on the shelf.	
Blood Pressure	Noun	Her blood pressure was a bit high today.	
Body	Noun	Where on your body does it hurt?	

Breathing	Verb	Susan's breathing was normal today.	
Call Light	Noun	I saw the call light on, do you need help?	
Cancer	Noun	This patient has cancer .	
Care Plan	Noun	There is a care plan in place.	
Cast	Noun	My wrist is in a cast .	
Chemotherapy	Noun	The patient will be receiving chemotherapy .	
Chest Pain	Noun	Do you have any chest pain ?	
To Clean	Verb	I will be cleaning the house today.

Inhaler	Noun	I will go get your inhaler for you.	
Needle	Noun	Here is a clean needle .	
Patient	Noun	Where is the patient ?	
Prescription	Noun	Is this the correct prescription ?	
Pulse	Noun	I need to check your pulse now.	

Ramp	Noun	Where is the wheelchair ramp ?	
Seizure	Noun	Your patient recently had a seizure .	
Stroke	Noun	Your patient recently had a stroke .	
Swollen	Noun	Your hand looks swollen .	
Symptoms	Noun	She has flu-like symptoms .	
Temperature	Noun	Let me take your temperature .	
Weak	Noun	Are you feeling weak today?	
Wheelchair	Noun	I have the wheelchair ready for you.
