<b>Attic</b>	Noun	The extra toys can be placed in the <b>attic</b> .	
<b>Basement</b>	Noun	The laundry room is in the <b>basement</b> .	
<b>Bathroom</b>	Noun	The <b>bathroom</b> needs to be cleaned next.	
<b>Bathtub</b>		Scrub the <b>bathtub</b> .	

<b>Bed</b>	Noun	Please make all of the <b>beds</b> .	
<b>Bedroom</b>	Noun	All of the <b>bedrooms</b> need to be cleaned	
<b>Bleach</b>	Noun	Use <b>bleach</b> on these white shirts.	
<b>Bookshelf</b>	Noun	Please organize the <b>bookshelf</b> .	
<b>Carpet</b>	Noun	The carpet needs to be vacuumed.	
<b>Carpet cleaner</b>	Noun	Put down some <b>carpet cleaner</b> first.	
<b>To Clean</b>	Verb	Please <b>clean</b> the kitchen first.	
<b>Couch</b>	Noun	There is a stain on the <b>couch</b> that needs to be removed.	
<b>Counter</b>	Noun	The <b>counter</b> in the kitchen is still messy.	
<b>Detergent</b>	Noun	I need to put <b>detergent</b> in the washer before turning it on.	
<b>Dining room</b>	Noun	The <b>dining room</b> needs to be vacuumed.	

<b>Dishes</b>	Noun	All of the <b>dishes</b> in the sink need to be cleaned.	
<b>Dishwasher</b>	Noun	Place all of the dirty dishes in the <b>dishwasher</b> .	
<b>Dusty</b>	Adjective	The bookcase is <b>dusty</b> .	
<b>To Dust</b>	Verb	Please <b>dust</b> it.	
<b>Dust pan</b>	Noun	Collect all of the dust into the <b>dust pan</b> .	
<b>Dryer</b>	Noun	Place all of the wet towels into the <b>dryer</b> .	
<b>To Empty</b>	Verb	Please <b>empty</b> the garbage.	
<b>Face towel</b>	Noun	Put the <b>face towels</b> in the washer.	
<b>To Finish</b>	Verb	I have not <b>finished</b> cleaning the bedrooms yet.	
<b>Fitted sheet</b>	Noun	The <b>fitted sheet</b> goes on first.	

<b>Flat sheet</b>	Noun	The <b>flat sheet</b> goes on top.	
<b>To Fold</b>	Verb	Please <b>fold</b> all of the towels.	
<b>Fireplace</b>	Noun	Dust the <b>fireplace</b> too, please.	
<b>Furniture</b>	Noun	Please polish all of the furniture.	
<b>Garbage</b>	Noun	The <b>garbage</b> is full.	
<b>Garbage bag</b>	Noun	Please put a <b>garbage bag</b> into the garbage pail.	
<b>Hand towel</b>	Noun	The <b>hand towels</b> need to be folded.	
<b>Hanger</b>	Noun	Place the wet clothes on the <b>hanger</b> .	
<b>To hang up</b>	Verb	<b>Hang up</b> this shirt.	
<b>Hallway</b>	Noun	Please dust the pictures hanging in the <b>hallway</b> .	
<b>Iron</b>	Noun	Careful, the iron is hot!	
<b>To Iron</b>	Verb	Iron all of the clothes in this pile.	

<b>Kitchen</b>	Noun	The <b>kitchen</b> needs to be cleaned first.	
<b>Laundry</b>	Noun	The <b>laundry</b> is almost finished.	
<b>Make the bed</b>	Verb	Did you <b>make the bed</b> in the master bedroom?	
<b>Master bedroom</b>	Noun	The <b>master bedroom</b> is last on the list to clean.	
<b>Messy</b>	Adjective	The children's rooms are <b>messy</b> .	
<b>Mirror</b>	Noun	Please use Windex on the <b>mirrors</b> too.	
<b>To Mop Up</b>	Verb	The dishwasher flooded, so I <b>mopped</b> up the water.	
<b>To Organize</b>	Verb	I <b>organized</b> the indoor and outdoor shoes.	
<b>Pillow case</b>	Noun	All of the <b>pillow cases</b> need to be changed.	
<b>To Polish</b>	Verb	Please <b>polish</b> the furniture.	
<b>Recycling bin</b>	Noun	The empty cans go in the <b>recycling bin</b> .	

<b>To Rinse</b>	Verb	You'll have to <b>rinse</b> the dishes a little better.	
<b>To Scrub</b>	Verb	You'll have to <b>scrub</b> the upstairs tub because it's pretty dirty.	
<b>Sponge</b>	Noun	This <b>sponge</b> will be good to clean the dishes.	
<b>Soap</b>	Noun	Use <b>soap</b> and water to clean the sink.	
<b>Stain Remover</b>	Noun	Use the <b>stain remover</b> on the couch.	
<b>To Sweep</b>	Noun	The hallways need to be <b>swept</b> .	
<b>To Vacuum</b>	Verb	Please pick up large items like coins before you <b>vacuum</b> the basement.	
<b>To Wash</b>	Verb	Please <b>wash</b> the windows with Windex.	
<b>Washing machine</b>	Noun	The <b>washing machine</b> stopped.	
<b>Windex</b>	Noun	<b>Windex</b> should be used on all of the windows.	
<b>Window</b>	Noun	This <b>window</b> is still dirty	
<b>Window sill</b>	Noun	The <b>window sills</b> are dusty.	
<b>To Wipe</b>	Verb	Don't use bleach to <b>wipe</b> the counters.
